

H-22 Information and Funding Information

What is an H-22?

An H-22 is a grade that will automatically be issued to any student registered for a Fall Term 2022 Class who is not able to resume/complete that course due to Hurricane Ian circumstances. No action is required by a student who cannot return to class (es) in order for this grade to be posted by faculty at the end of the Fall Term 2022 in lieu of a regular letter grade.

- An H-22 designation will allow students to retake the course at no additional cost (including textbooks) in the Spring 2023 or Summer 2023 semester only.
- The H-22 will appear on the student transcript, but will not adversely impact GPA or financial aid status.
- If a student re-registers for and completes the course within the published timeframe, that earned letter grade will then be noted on the transcript and calculated into the GPA.
- If the course for which the H-22 has been issued is not retaken and completed by the student in the published timeframe, the H-22 will automatically become a grade of "W" (withdrawal) as currently defined.

Please note again: The H-22 grade is not for resumption of a class, but rather for a complete re-registration and re-take during Spring 2023 or Summer 2023 at no cost to the student.

How will H-22 impact me if I receive funding from **Bright Futures**:

- H-22 class(s) will be treated the same as a "Withdrawal"
 - o The amount of funds paid by Bright Futures for the class(s) will be backed off of the student account and returned to the Florida Department of Education. The student is required to pay the funds to FSW.
 - Renewal eligibility for Bright Futures for 2023-2024 requires the repayment of the funds to FSW.

When retaking the class in spring or summer will I receive funding from **Bright Futures** for the class(s)?

- Yes, as long as you have hours of funding eligibility available.
 - o Renewal eligibility for 2023-2024 is contingent upon meeting all **Bright Futures** renewal eligibility criteria, including repayment of withdrawn hours and H-22 hours.

How will H-22 impact me if I receive funding from **Vocational Rehabilitation** or **CareerSource**:

- H-22 grades will not negatively impact a student receiving **Vocational Rehabilitation** or **CareerSource** funding for fall semester.
- The class(es) will be viewed as a Withdrawal (W).
- Vocational Rehab and CareerSource will not pay for the class when retaken in spring or summer since there will not be charge for the class(es).
