Question Of The Week

"How many credits do I need to be a full-time student?"

Answer: To be considered a **full-time student**, you must be enrolled in **twelve credits or more** during the Fall, Spring, or Summer semesters or six credits or more during a minisemester.

Part-time students are enrolled in fewer than twelve credits during the Fall, Spring, or Summer semesters or fewer than six credits during a mini-semester.
