### Question Of The Week

"I've been taking classes at FSW for an academic year (fall, spring, summer). How do I know if I'm a freshman or a sophomore?"

**Answer:** According to the [FSW 2021 - 2022 College Catalog](#), a student's category is determined by the number of credits they have earned. A student who has earned less than 30 college credits is considered to be a freshman. A student who has earned 30 but less than 60 college credits is considered to be a sophomore. A student who has earned 60 but less than 90 college credits is considered to be a junior, and a student who has earned 90 or more credits prior to completing baccalaureate requirements is considered to be a senior.
